IRA London bombings

17 December 1992: A bomb hidden in a litter bin in a third-floor men's lavatory of the John Lewis department store Oxford street by the IRA detonated just after 11 am. Four people were injured.

A second bomb exploded 15 minutes later at the rear of the store, in Cavendish square while shoppers and staff were still being evacuated injuring three people.

Firebomb attacks

Firebomb attacks have caused a major blaze at a retail park in Boucher Road in Belfast and two city stores.

The Homebase store has been destroyed. More than 70 firefighters are tackling the blaze, which has spread to Reid's furniture store next door.



"At one stage, there was an explosion involving gas cylinders inside the Homebase area, which hampered firefighting efforts.

Arsonist Homebase Aylesford

Police have praised the "swift action" of staff who helped evacuate a Kent retail park that was engulfed by a major fire.

At the height of the incident about 90 firefighters tackled the blaze at South Aylesford Retail Park, which lasted for nearly 42 hours.

Det Ch Insp Jon Clayden said: "Members of staff should be commended for their swift actions in evacuating the store.

"Had this not been the case the outcome could have been very different."

The fire started in Homebase on Saturday and spread to Carpetright, causing staff and about 80 shoppers to flee as flames ripped through the site.

'Treated as suspicious'

Kent Police said the building was structurally unsafe and until it was made safe officers would not be able to access to the store.

The fire is currently being treated as suspicious.

Officers are also investigating whether the incident could be linked to a blaze at a B&Q store in nearby Larkfield

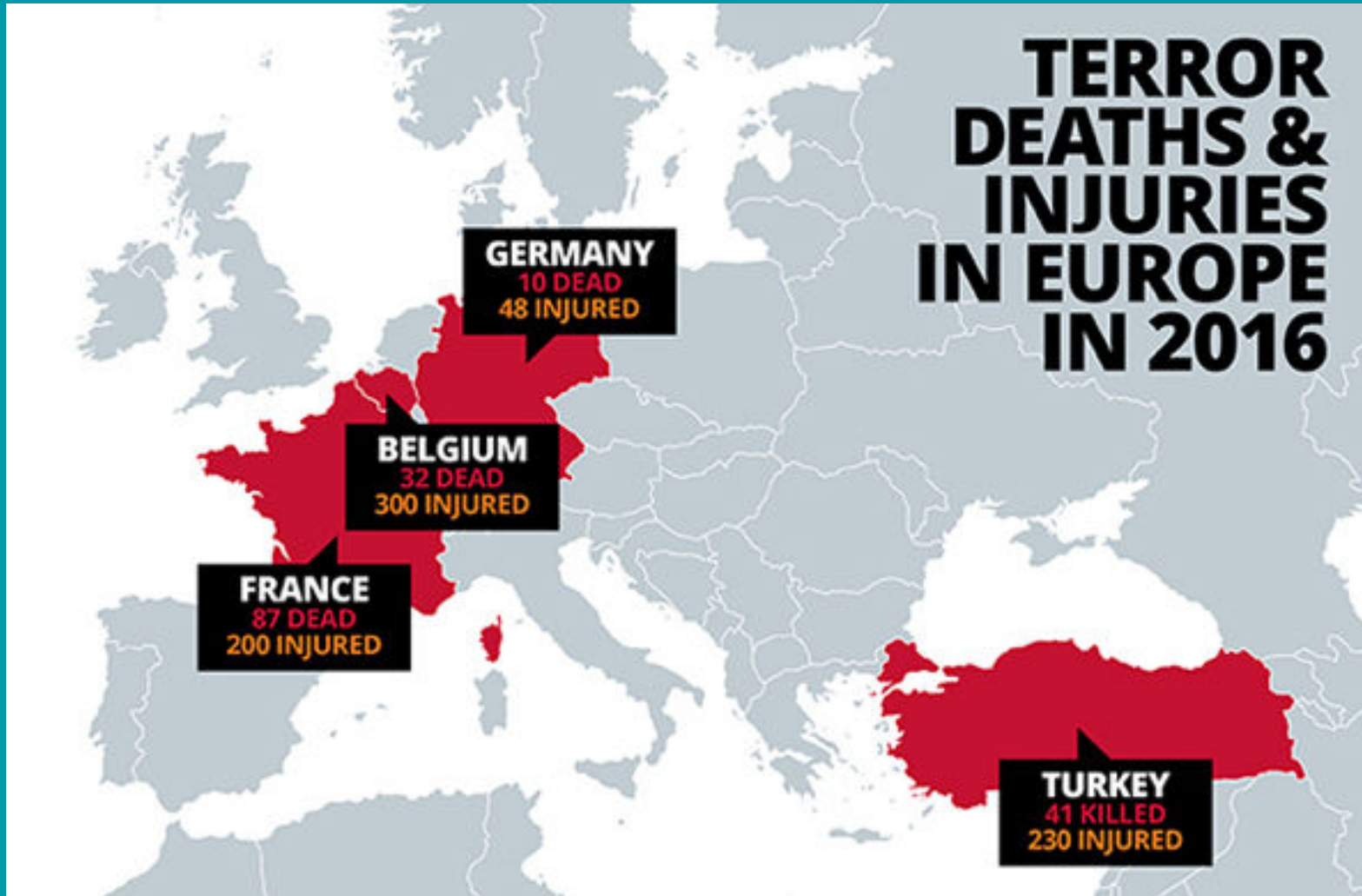
