D2N2 TEAM JOINS THE EAST MIDLANDS COMBINED COUNTY AUTHORITY

This week, the D2N2 LEP staff team joined the East Midlands Combined County Authority (EMCCA).

The D2N2 Local Enterprise Partnership (LEP) was established in 2010, alongside over 30 other LEPs across the country, with the purpose of driving local economic development in our region.

As part of the devolution deal agreed with government that established EMCCA, the LEP's board agreed that its staff team and functions would be incorporated into the EMCCA to deliver a unified approach to tackling the region's challenges. The move means that all 20 LEP staff have now joined the EMCCA, delivering improvements in transport, housing, skills and adult education, and net zero.
