NEW LEADER APPOINTED AT DERBY CITY COUNCIL

Cllr Nadine Peatfield has been appointed as the new leader of Derby City Council, after the previous leader, Cllr Baggy Shanker, lost a vote of no confidence.

The no-confidence motion was raised on Tuesday 18 June, following new developments relating to the Sinfin Waste Plant, in which the City Council has received a £93.9 million invoice from Derbyshire County Council.

The vote ended tied at 25 for and 25 against, with the city's new mayor Councillor Ged Potter using his casting vote in support of the proposed motion.
