Postponement of Local Authority Elections

The Government have announced that elections scheduled for 7th May will be postponed for 29 councils, including that for City of Lincoln Council. The intention is to release capacity for councils to deliver LGR, as well as addressing concerns regarding the cost of holding elections for councils that will soon cease to exist. Legislation will be brought forward to enable the postponement for a period of one year.

Road conditions in England to March 2026

This week DfT have released official statistics into the road conditions in England to March 2025. This annual release presents information on the condition of roads in England, covering surface condition, skidding resistance and highway maintenance treatments and expenditure.

Automated survey machines and visual surveys are used by local authorities and National Highways (NH) to monitor the condition of the road surface.
