### ILM 3 Award in Leadership and Management (6 days)

This is a 6-day programme designed for those currently managing or aspiring to lead multi-disciplinary teams, particularly within the context of local government, with cross-functional collaboration. It is ideally suited to officers and managers who work through influence and partnerships to deliver outcomes. The course covers essential leadership and management topics to build confidence in navigating complex challenges, improving service quality, and driving innovation in public service delivery.
